**Brief Overview:** This funding opportunity aims to support community organizations serving the Eaton fire-affected areas in delivering community education and outreach on the health impacts of large wild-urban fires and how to reduce exposure using tools developed by UCLA environmental health researchers. Grant awardees will 1) receive training and educational resources from UCLA researchers on the health impacts of wildfires, and 2) be responsible for conducting community health outreach and education for the wildfire-impacted Eaton area. 


